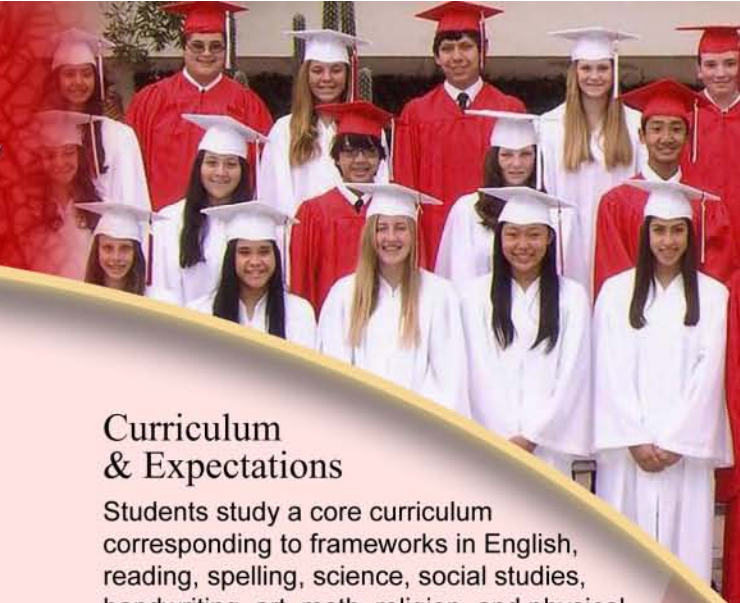

And although our students consistently score higher than national averages on standardized testing, each student is valued for their own unique gifts and not just for their academic standing – a reflection of the sense of individual dignity which is central to the mission of St. John Eudes School.
