Dear Mrs. Danowitz, Faculty & Students,

Greetings to each of you from India! I always rejoice to hear news from or about our SJE Family, and learn about the GREAT things you are doing for the Kingdom of God – especially forming loving families who live the message of Jesus

Since St. John Eudes Church & School have always been responsive to the needs of others, I decided to share with you about a six year old boy I know who has slowly become blind.

Anil lives in Andhra Pradesh with his twin sister, two older brothers (8 & 10), mother and father. Father had been an auto rickshaw driver, but he had a stroke four years ago which left him paralyzed on one side. Both Anil and his twin sister have slowly been losing their eyesight, so they took them to the hospital where his sister had a surgery which restored her sight. But they were informed that Anil needs a more complicated surgery in a specialized hospital in Hyderabad. This is impossible for the family because the surgery costs more than 1 lakh (\$1500 in US dollars), and the mother earns about \$50 a month (3500 rupees) to support the family.

Just as Mother Paula made her students aware of a classmate's need for a new pair of shoes, so I am doing the same in presenting the need of Anil for an operation.

I ask you to PRAY for Anil and his family, and if you are able to help provide funds for his surgery, you would be the answer to his prayers.

You and your families are always remembered in my prayers. Please pray for me, too!
