All donors will be recognized in a special publication at the end of the program year. But, in order to protect the privacy of students, families, and donors, the names of students and their Adoptive Donors will not be revealed to each other. However, whatever level of your participation, you can be assured that 100% of your gift is used to help a student, with no funds used for administrative costs.

Studies have shown time and time again that Catholic schools offer children of lower income families the best hope of receiving a quality education and of escaping poverty and discrimination, and thus help build and support family values and social ethics.

An investment in the St. John Eudes Adopt-A-Student Program is an investment in the life of a child, in the community, and in the future.



About the Program

When a student's family applies for financial assistance, the student is placed on a list according to greatest need through an objective ranking known as the “FACTS Tuition Aid Assessment”.

Gifts of \$500 or more are allocated directly to a specific child on the list, in order of need, and are used to help pay that particular student's fees and tuition for the year. Those donors gifting at that level are considered as “Adoptive Donors” and will be recognized yearly on a Donor Plaque maintained in the School Office and receive a Certificate of Recognition for their participation in the
