## **4<sup>th</sup> Grade SUPPLIES LIST 2018 - 2019**

### **General Items (Keep in desk and pencil pouch)**

- 1 set of 12 washable broad tip markers
- 1 set of 12 washable fine tip markers
- 1 mini dry erase Board (no larger than 9" x 12")
- 1 12 pack dry erase markers (multi-colored)
- 1 eraser for dry erase board
- 1 box of 12 crayons
- 1 set of 12 color pencils
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 small personal stapler with extra staples
- 1 - 12" ruler (inches and centimeters)
- 1 pack black or blue ballpoint pens
- 1 pencil pouch or pencil box (9"X5")
- 2 - 1" binders (double pockets at the bottom for Science and Vocabulary)
- 3 thin pocket folders
- 2 reams of wide-ruled lined paper
- 6 composition books (different colors, one RED needed for Spanish)
- 1 – Erasers (white preferred)

### **Communal Supply List**

- 1 - pack baby wipes (if your family name starts with A – L) per trimester

- 24 - #2 pencils (Pre-sharpened are preferred. Please sharpen pencils at home, NOT in class)
- 1 - glue stick
